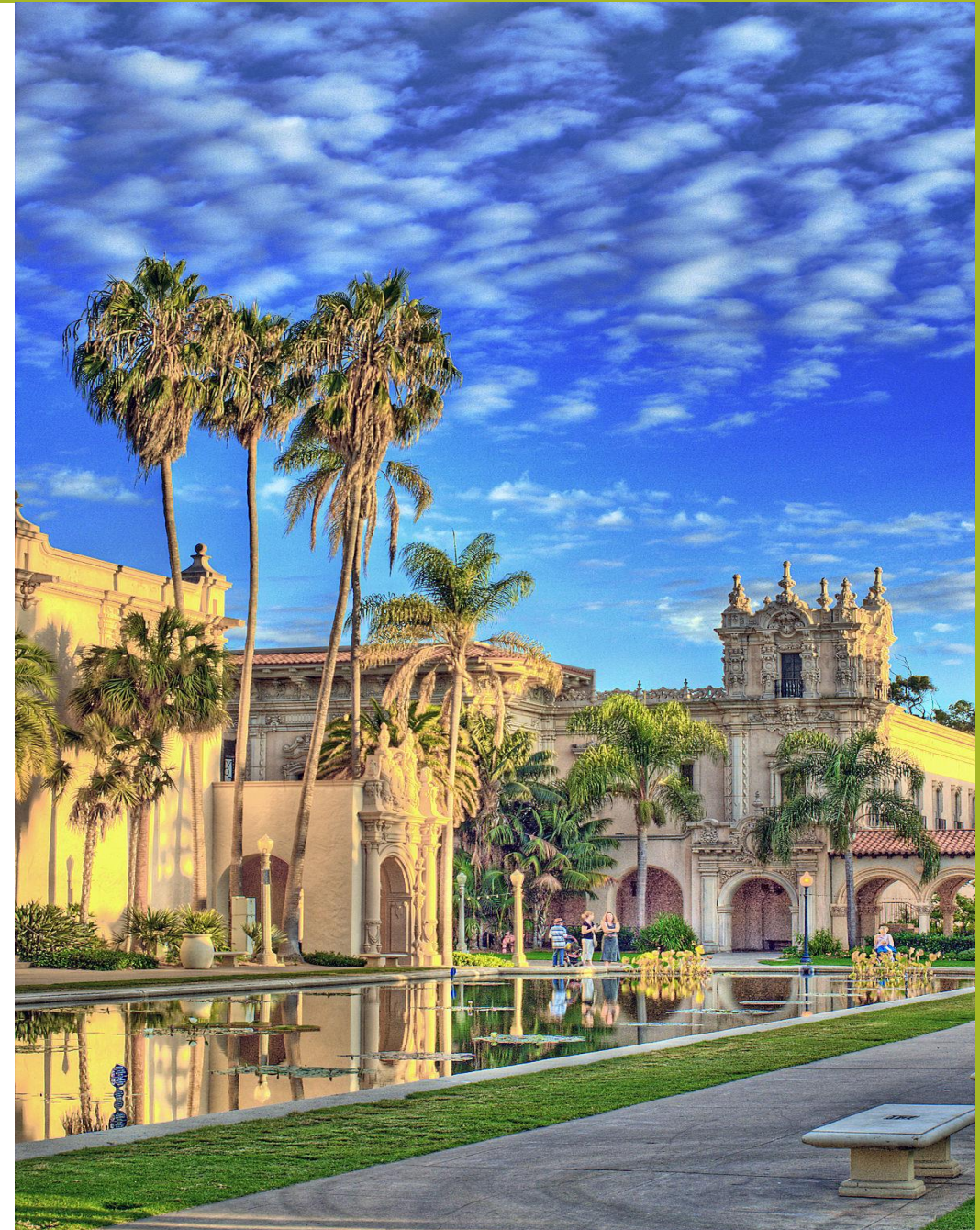

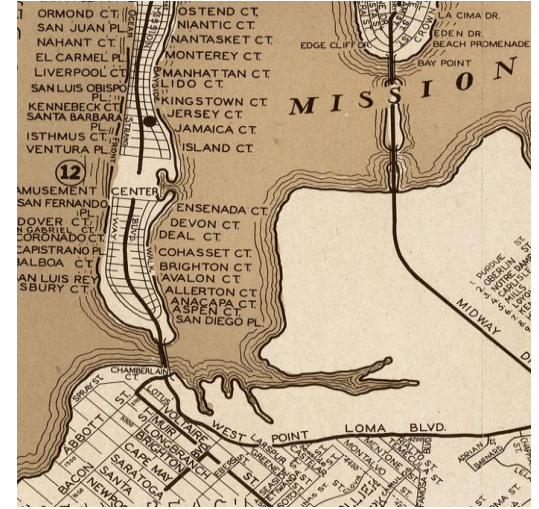


San Diego basics

Sports

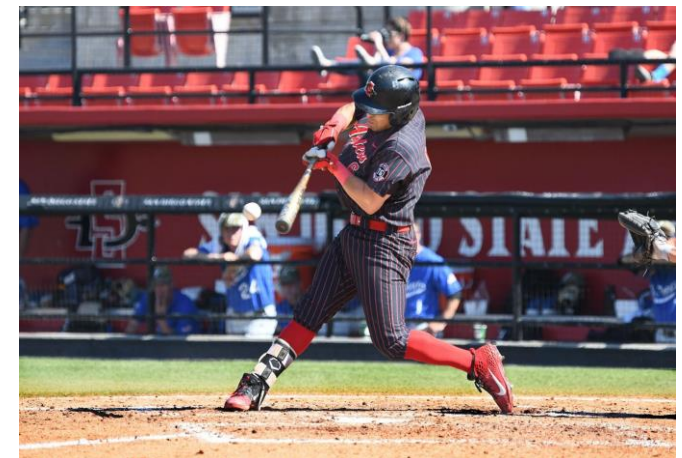


-San Diego is very successful in sports

the city is home to numerous historic sites that played a role in the settlement of Alta California.

Mission Basilica San Diego de Alcalá

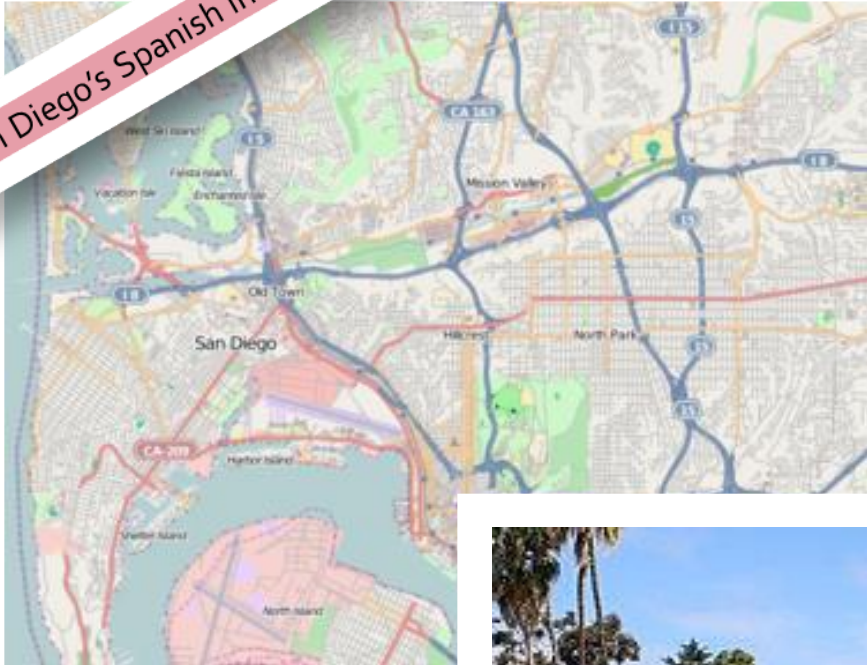
- It was the first Franciscan mission in The Californias, a province of New Spain
- it was founded in 1769 by Spanish friar Junípero Serra
- the present building still serves as an active parish church and cultural center

Old Town San Diego State Historic Park

- located in the Old Town neighborhood of San Diego
- It commemorates the early days of the City of San Diego and includes many historic buildings from the period 1820 to 1870
- Five original adobe buildings are part of the complex, which includes shops, restaurants and museums

HISTORICAL SITES

Balboa Park

- In addition to open space areas, natural vegetation zones, green belts, gardens, and walking paths, it contains museums, several theaters, and the world-famous San Diego Zoo
- the park's site is one of the oldest in the United States dedicated to public recreational use
- Spain and later Mexico made a practice of setting aside large tracts of land for the common use of citizens, this land included the site of present-day Balboa Park

CUISINE



- The city is renowned for its wide selection of excellent Mexican restaurants, which are major players on the San Diego food scene
- There are conveniently located family-run taco shops, fast casual eateries specializing in Mexican street food and popular historic restaurants where women make tortillas by hand
- You can enjoy tamales, burritos and enchiladas made from fresh, local ingredients all over town

- Latino Film Festival
- The San Diego Latino Film Festival (SDLFF) is presented and produced by Media Arts Center San Diego
- The San Diego Latino Film Festival is a 11-day celebration of Latino Cinema, Arts & Culture
- Media Arts Center San Diego's San Diego Latino Film Festival was established 27 years ago initially as a student film festival focusing on works by Latinos

Linda Vista Multicultural Fair & Parade

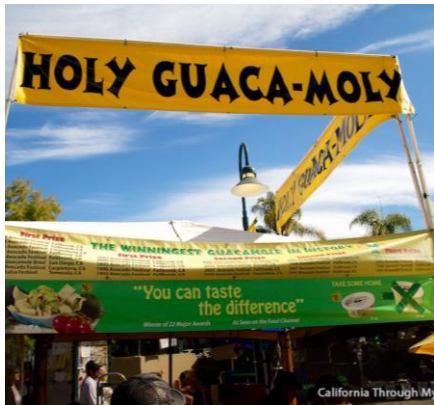
- It was founded in 1985
- The parade is intended to promote cultural awareness and celebrate the diversity within the city of San Diego
- There are many cultural exhibits, varied ethnic food offerings and artistic performances





INTERESTING FACTS

- San Diego airport is currently the busiest single runway airport in the U.S, and in 2nd place in the World
- San Diego County has the most small farms of any US county and produces the most avocados
- Fallbrook in San Diego is the Avocado capital of the world. Last year the Avocado Festival attracted over 70,000 people



INTERESTING FACTS

- San Diego has more fleas than any other city in the USA
- The first drive-in restaurant in the United States was opened in San Diego by the man who later founded Jack in the Box in 1951
- San Diego is home to the worlds oldest active sailing ship, The Star Of India. (She was built at Ramsey Shipyard in the Isle of Man in 1863, and was originally named Euterpe, after the Greek muse of music and poetry)
